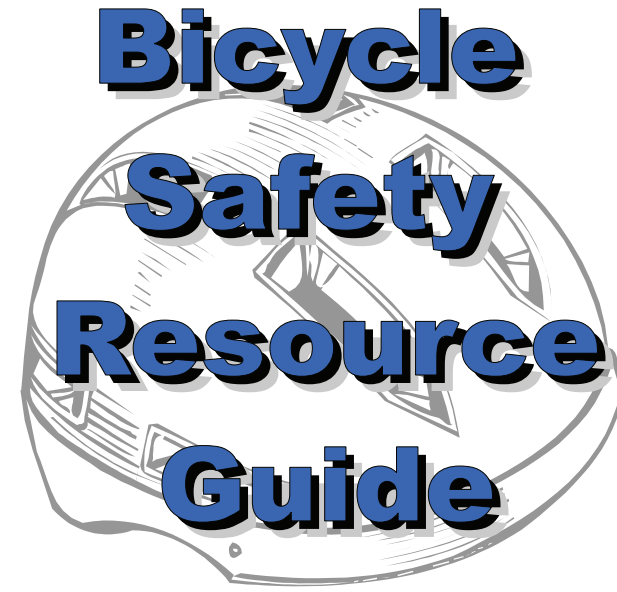

Bicycling Do It - But Do It Right

Bicycle riding is a wonderful experience that combines fun, recreation, and the health benefits of sunshine, fresh air, and exercise. As a mode of transportation, bike riding helps reduce traffic congestion and supports a clean environment. Unfortunately, riders can be seriously injured. Sonoma county reports the 5th highest rate of bicyclists injured or killed in traffic collisions (when comparing all counties in California by vehicle miles traveled). About one in four of these bicycle collisions involve child bicyclists under the age of 15. Compared to California as a whole, children in Sonoma County have a higher rate of hospitalizations from bicycle collisions.

Many children are involved in traffic collisions because they are violating traffic laws (running stop signs, not using signals, and riding against the flow of traffic). The majority of bicyclists injured are those not wearing helmets (nearly three out of four). Wearing a properly fitted bike helmet and following traffic laws are effective measures for reducing the risk of injuries and death to bicyclists.
